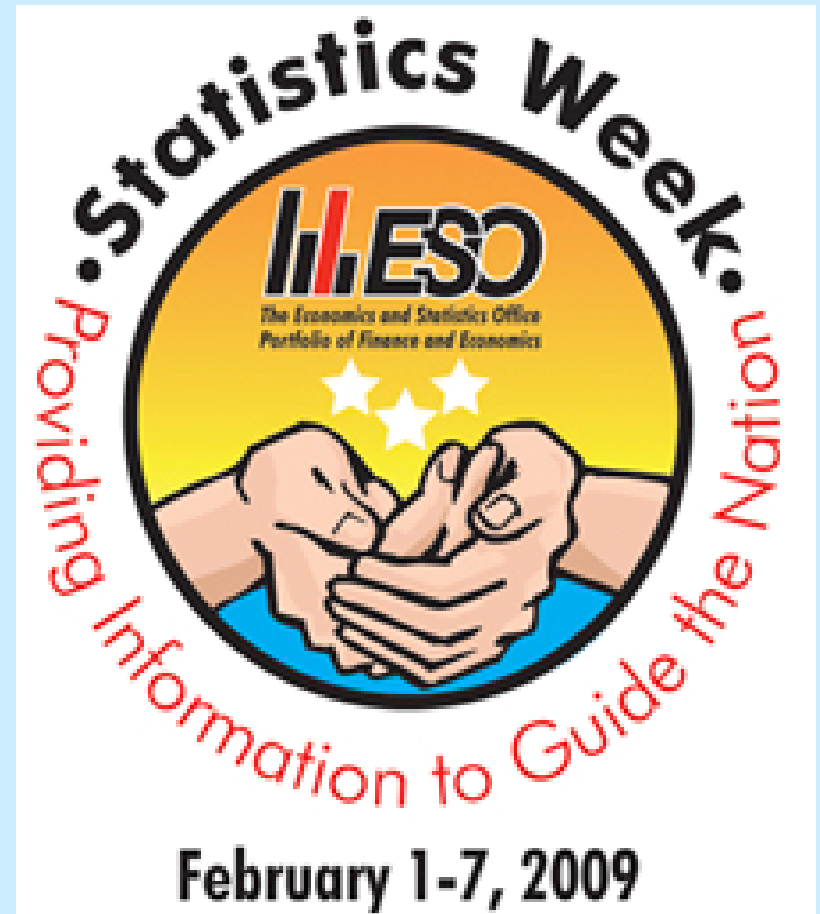

Join and Celebrate

The First Annual "Statistics Week" in the Cayman Islands, 1st-7th February 2009

In 1997, the United Nations Statistical Commission in its 29th session strongly recommended that countries which were not celebrating statistical days or weeks should begin to do so as soon as feasible.

The purpose of the Statistics Week are as follows:

- ◆ To promote people's awareness of statistics and their value, and encourage their support for statistics and for providing data;
- ◆ To promote the use of statistics;
- ◆ To bring together users and producers of statistics; and
- ◆ To improve relationships between the statistical office and the media.

Currently, a total of 99 countries have been or will be celebrating statistics day/week/month. About twenty of these are from the Caribbean, such as Jamaica, Bermuda, Bahamas, Anguilla, Turks and Caicos Islands, Barbados, Trinidad and Tobago.

As its contribution to the international celebration of Statistics, the Cayman Islands is celebrating its first ever Statistics Week from 1st – 7th February, 2009, comprising the first ever "Statistics Week." The slogan of the week is "Statistics: Providing Information to Guide the Nation"

The key activities are as follows:

- ◆ Presentations of "Statistics and You" among Grade 11 students in Grand Cayman and Cayman Brac, Grade 9 students of George Hicks High and target students of the University College of the Cayman Islands.
- ◆ Basic orientation training for users of statistics in government departments. Two groups comprising 15-20 employees will be trained for 5 ½ hours of official time per group.
- ◆ Other activities include an ESO staff development workshop and presentation of awards to staff members with outstanding contribution; and public activities such as a church thanksgiving service; and a visit to Pines Retirement Home.
